Assistance

A.A.R.P. trained volunteers are available at the library, beginning Sat., February 4, to assist middle and low-income seniors in filing their tax returns. There is no charge for this service. Forms

As forms are available on-line, the library does not have paper tax forms available in bulk. The IRS provides reproducible versions of the most commonly used Federal forms which are available for photocopying at the library. Southern Pines Public Library cardholders may reserve an Internet computer to download and print forms. Due to the volume of demand, the reference staff cannot download forms for you.
